What type of insurance is this?

Health insurance for a child who at the time of signing the insurance contract application is under two years of age, providing health services in accordance with medical indications



What type of insurance is this?

The health of the insured, the care of which involves providing medical services at selected medical facilities in the following range:

- ✓ consultations with doctors of the most common specialties: paediatrician, surgeon, cardiologist, ENT specialist, neonatologist, neurologist, ophthalmologist, orthopaedist
- ✓ home visits from paediatrician – 10 per year
- ✓ selected laboratory tests and diagnostics, including biochemistry, haematology, bacterial cultures, stool and urine tests, X-ray, ultrasound, resting ECG
- ✓ ambulance and medical transport
- ✓ emergency medical services – 24/7 Medicover Hot Line
- ✓ flu vaccination
- ✓ mandatory vaccinations for newborn babies: pneumo-coccus, diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, Hib, polio-IPV, hepatitis B, measles, mumps, rubella
- ✓ recommended vaccinations: rotavirus, 50% discount: chickenpox, meningococcal



What is not covered by insurance?

- ✗ comprehensive range of tests and specialists
- ✗ hospital procedures and services
- ✗ highly specialised procedures
- ✗ rehabilitation
(the above types of services are available in the Elite for Baby+ insurance package)
- ✗ the cost of purchasing medications, prostheses, implants, stimulators, pacemakers, valves, lenses, glasses, contact lenses, or highly specialised medical supplies



What are the limitations of insurance coverage?

Insurance coverage does not extend to the following:

- ! if the medical service was intended for, was the result of, or was caused by:
 - chronic dialysis treatment
 - conditions related to HIV infection or AIDS
 - o treatment considered to be experimental
 - o aesthetic or cosmetic medicine



Where does insurance coverage apply?

- ✓ at Medicover healthcare centres in Poland: Medicover Centre and partner facilities



What are the responsibilities of the insured?

- timely payment of premiums in the amount and by the date specified in the policy



How and when should premiums be paid?

- in a method and frequency agreed to with the Insurer



When does insurance coverage begin and end?

- insurance coverage begins on the date agreed to with the Insurer and ends after 12 months, with the possibility of extending the contract



How to terminate the contract?

- The insurance contract may be terminated in writing with a 30-day notice period, calculated from the first day of the month of insurance following the day when the Insurer receives a written withdrawal from the contract.
